EDUC 208 and EDUC 209 are prerequisite (or co-requisite) courses for all Education courses. Plan to take EDUC 208/EDUC 209 during your first semester of Education coursework.
 Should a transfer student be able to document the successful completion of an introductory education course, they will receive credit for EDUC 208. The transfer student will still need to complete EDUC 209 Teacher Education Orientation & Practicum and should plan to enroll in this course during the first semester in which one or more other Education courses are take.
 All required coursework in the Education Core and Endorsements must be completed with a minimum grade of "C-" and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be admitted to and remain in the Teacher Education program. In order to be admitted to EDUC 410, EDUC 411, EDUC 412, EDUC 413, SPED 421 or SPED 425 Special Education Student Teaching, a GPA of 2.75 in the major field of study is required.
 All teacher education students must take PSYC 250 Human Growth & Development. This course can also be counted toward the general education requirements for Social Science.
 Students must complete the following coursework in the General Studies requirements.
